









Note

Hang the lamp at eye level or slightly higher. This prevents glare from the light source. The distance to the ceiling, as well as z. B. to a table under the light, must be at least 0.5m each.

ATTENTION!

Before installation, the connecting cable must be de-energized.

Assembly:

It is recommended that the installation be carried out by a specialist company. We ask for your understanding that we can only assume a warranty if properly installed.

- Loosen the fastening screws and disconnect the luminaire part from the wall housing. The fastening screws remain in the wall housing.
- Feed the supply cable through the cable gland and mark the drill holes through the mounting holes of the wall housing.
- 3 Fix the mounting plate to the wall with a dowel and screw.
- 4. Connect the supply cables to the ballast and the ground wire.
- Plug the two connectors together and hook the light part onto the mounting screws. Make sure that no cable is pinched.
- 6. Hand-tighten the fastening screws.
- The light is grounded when the wall plate is properly connected to the mounting plate.
- 8. The fixing screws must not be loosened by hand. Use a toothed washer on one of the four screws to prevent the screw from loosening. (According to DIN EN60598, in the case of mechanical connections that represent a protective ground connection, it must be prevented that this connection is loosened). The luminaire may only be operated when fully assembled.

Dimming

The ballast has an interface for a 1-10V dimmer. Dimmer please test before the permanent installation.

Cleaning

It is recommended to clean the lamp with a soft, dry cloth. The glass elements can be cleaned with any commercially available glass cleaner.
