









Note:

The distance to the ceiling, as well as to objects and persons under the luminaire, must be at least $0.5 \mathrm{m}$ in each case.

ATTENTION!

Before installation, the connecting cable must be de-energized.

Assembl

It is recommended that the installation be carried out by a specialist company. We ask for your understanding that we can only assume a warranty if properly installed.

- Determine the position of the chandelier in the room and place it on a clean, soft surface on the floor first.
- 2. Solder the suspension and cable entry to the ceiling.
- Attach the ceiling brackets to the ceiling, pull the rope through the cap and ball it onto the ceiling part.
- 4. Insert the rope ends into the rope holders of the chandelier and pull the rope through the rope holder until the chandelier hangs at the desired height.
- 5. Insert the light cable through the lid of the canopy and clamp it under the strain relief. Then shorten the cable and connect it to the supply line.
- Adjust the candlestick with the aid of a spirit level and then shorten the projecting ropes.
 Observe the illustration for handling the cable holders.
- Mount the glass elements with the countersunk screws on the fixing lugs, these can be turned for assembly.

dimming:

The light is dimmable, depending on the light source. Please read the instructions of the illuminant manufacturer.

Cleaning:

It is recommended to clean the lamp with a soft, dry cloth. The glass elements can be cleaned with any commercially available glass cleaner.
